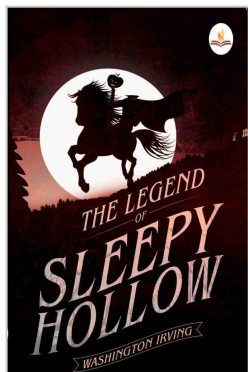

Washington Irving

Washington Irving (1783–1859) was an influential American writer best known for his short stories and as a pioneer of American literature. His famous tale, *The Legend of Sleepy Hollow* (1820), introduced readers to the eerie character of the Headless Horseman and captured early American folklore. Irving's works, which also include *Rip Van Winkle*, combined humor, vivid descriptions, and a sense of the supernatural, helping to establish a uniquely American literary identity in the 19th century.

Product Description

The Legend of Sleepy Hollow is a short story by Washington Irving, first published in 1820. It is part of his collection *The Sketch Book of Geoffrey Crayon, Gent.* and tells the tale of Ichabod Crane, a schoolteacher who competes for the love of Katrina Van Tassel with Brom Bones. During a party, Ichabod hears the story of the Headless Horseman, a ghostly soldier who searches for his lost head. After a terrifying chase, Ichabod disappears, leaving behind only his hat and a broken pumpkin, suggesting he fled in fear.
