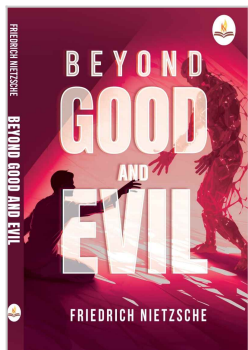

Friedrich Nietzsche was a German philosopher and cultural critic known for his influential ideas on truth, morality, and power.
