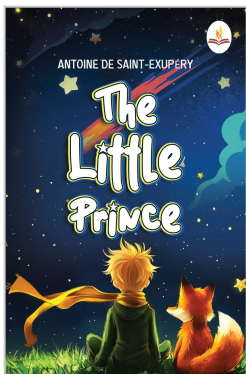

Antoine de Saint-Exupéry

Antoine de Saint-Exupéry was a French aviator and writer born in Lyon. He pioneered international airmail routes across Africa and South America, experiences that inspired his literary works. His notable books include Southern Mail (1929), Night Flight (1931), Wind, Sand and Stars (1939), and The Little Prince (1943). During World War II, he returned to active duty with the Free French Air Force. On July 31, 1944, he disappeared during a reconnaissance mission over the Mediterranean; his plane was found in 2000 near Marseille, though the exact

cause of his crash remains unknown.

Product Description

The Little Prince (Le Petit Prince) is a 1943 novella by French aviator Antoine de Saint-Exupéry that follows a pilot stranded in the Sahara who meets a young boy from asteroid B-612. The boy shares tales of caring for his rose and uprooting baobabs on his tiny planet, encounters eccentric adults on six asteroids, and, on Earth, learns from a fox that “what is essential is invisible to the eye.” Ultimately, he accepts a snake’s bite to return home, leaving his body but freeing his spirit.
